



# The Mexican Revolution in Film, Photography, and Fiction

(Course conducted in English)

LTWL 4F: This course offers an introduction to the history of the Mexican Revolution (1910-1920) through film, photography, and works of fiction. The Mexican Revolution was one of the most photographed military conflicts of the 20th century and extensive newsreel exists of the war itself. We will analyze some of these images as well as classic cinematographic recreations from the 1930s and 1940s. This material will be studied in conjunction with key literary narratives from the post-revolutionary period (1920-1950).
