Course Requirements by concentration

Lower Division Requirements

English (6 total)

LTEN 21, LTEN 22, LTEN 23, LTEN 25, LTEN 26, and any one of the following: LTEN 27, LTEN 28, or LTEN 29

<u>French</u> (no direct requirements, but the French language sequence below is a pre-requisite for all UD LTFR courses) LIFR $1A/1AX \rightarrow LIFR 1B/1BX \rightarrow LIFR 1C/1CX \rightarrow LTFR 2A \rightarrow LTFR 2B \rightarrow LTFR 2C or LTFR 50$

<u>German</u> (no direct requirements, but the German language sequence below is a pre-requisite for all UD LTGM courses) LIGM 1A/1AX → LIGM 1B/1BX → LIGM 1C/1CX → LTGM 2A → LTGM 2B → LTGM 2C

<u>Italian</u> (no direct requirements, but the Italian language sequence below is a pre-requisite for all UD LTIT courses) LIIT $1A/1AX \rightarrow LIIT 1B/1BX \rightarrow LIIT 1C/1CX \rightarrow LTIT 2A \rightarrow LTIT 2B \rightarrow LTIT 50$

Russian (no direct requirements, but the Russian language sequence below is a pre-requisite for all UD LTRU courses) LTRU 1A \rightarrow LTRU 1B \rightarrow LTRU 1C \rightarrow LTRU 2A \rightarrow LTRU 2B \rightarrow LTRU 2C

Spanish (2 total)

LTSP 50A and one of the following: LTSP 50B or LTSP 50C

(not direct requirements, but the Spanish language sequence below is a pre-requisite for all LTSP 50 courses) LISP $1A/1AX \rightarrow LISP \ 1B/1BX \rightarrow LISP \ 1C/1CX \rightarrow LTSP \ 2A \rightarrow LTSP \ 2B$

Direct requirements for the concentrations must be taken for a letter grade.

Courses listed as pre-requisites may be taken as pass/no pass.

Upper Division Requirements

English (5 specific & 3 elective)

1 course from each of the following categories:

British Lit pre-1660 ("a"), British Lit post-1660 ("b"), U.S. Lit pre-1860 ("c"), and U.S. Lit post-1860 ("d");

- 1 of the following courses: LTCS 100, LTTH 110, or LTTH 115;
- 3 upper division English Lit electives (any upper division LTEN courses)

French (5 specific & 3 elective)

LTFR 115 and LTFR 116;

1 course from each of the following categories:

17th or 18th Century French Lit, 19th Century French Lit, 20th Century French Lit;

3 upper division French Lit electives (any upper division LTFR courses)

German (2 specific & 6 elective)

2 pre-1850 German Lit courses;

6 upper division German Lit electives (any upper division LTGM courses)

Italian (3 specific & 5 elective)

LTIT 100, LTIT 115, and LTIT 161;

5 upper division Italian Lit electives (any upper division LTIT courses)

Russian (6 specific & 2 elective)

LTRU 104A, LTRU 104B, LTRU 104C, LTRU 110A, LTRU 110B, and LTRU 110C; 2 upper division Russian Lit electives (any upper division LTRU courses)

Spanish (2 specific & 6 elective)

1 course from each of the following categories:

Peninsular Spanish Lit pre-1900 ("SP") and Latin American Lit pre-1900 ("LA"); 6 upper division Spanish Lit electives (any upper division LTSP courses)
