Lower Division Requirements

The French language sequence must be completed before taking any upper division LTFR courses. <u>Contact an advisor</u> for help determining where in the sequence you should be starting.

1st-year: LIFR 1A/1AX \rightarrow LIFR 1B/1BX \rightarrow LIFR 1C/1CX 2nd-year: LTFR 2A \rightarrow LTFR 2B \rightarrow LTFR 2C or LTFR 50

Secondary Literature COURSE OPTIONS

All Literature majors are required to become fluent in a second language and take at least one upper division Literature course in the language. The number of courses needed to complete this requirement varies depending on the language you choose and your proficiency in that language. Where you place in a given language sequence can be determined by an AP score, past articulated coursework, or a placement exam. Please contact our advisors for more details.

English Option

As a French Literature major, English can be used for the Secondary Literature requirement. As upper division LTEN courses do not have pre-requisites, you will be able to take 3 upper division LTEN courses to fulfill 6 major requirements. These courses would overlap to fulfill the Secondary Literature requirement and all three upper division elective courses (Please Note: you have the option of taking up to 2 lower division LTEN courses towards the Secondary Literature requirement, however they will not overlap in the same way).

For the last 2 steps you may take LTKO 3 twice <mark>and LTKO 100 o</mark>nce <u>OR</u> take L<mark>TKO 3 once</mark> and LTKO 100 t<mark>wice.</mark>

Latin

LTLA 1 \rightarrow LTLA 2 \rightarrow LTLA 3 \rightarrow UD LTLA

There is also a Summer Session option of LTLA 4, which counts as LTLA 1, LTLA 2, and LTLA 3 combined.

Russiar

LTRU 1A \rightarrow LTRU 1B \rightarrow LTRU 1C \rightarrow LTRU 2A \rightarrow LTRU 2B \rightarrow LTRU 2C \rightarrow UD LTRU

Spanish

LISP $1A/1AX \rightarrow LISP \ 1B/1BX \rightarrow LISP \ 1C/1CX \rightarrow LTSP \ 2A \rightarrow LTSP \ 2B \rightarrow LTSP \ 2C \rightarrow LTSP \ 50 \ A/B/C \rightarrow UD \ LTSP$ For the last 2 steps you may take 2 LTSP 50 courses (A, B, or C) and 1 UD LTSP course OR you may take 1 LTSP 50 course (A, B, or C) and 2 UD LTSP courses.

The courses that are **bold** are the ones that will directly apply to the Secondary Literature Requirement for your major, so they must be taken for a letter grade. All other courses leading up to those may be taken pass/no pass.
