Lower Division Requirements

The Russian language sequence must be completed before taking any upper division LTRU courses. <u>Contact an advisor</u> for help determining where in the sequence you should be starting.

<u>1st-year</u>: LTRU 1A \rightarrow LTRU 1B \rightarrow LTRU 1C 2nd-year: LTRU 2A \rightarrow LTRU 2B \rightarrow LTRU 2C

Secondary Literature COURSE OPTIONS

All Literature majors are required to become fluent in a second language and take at least one upper division Literature course in the language. The number of courses needed to complete this requirement varies depending on the language you choose and your proficiency in that language. Where you place in a given language sequence can be determined by an AP score, past articulated coursework, or a placement exam. Please <u>contact our advisors</u> for more details.

English Option

As a Russian Literature major, English can be used for the Secondary Literature requirement. Three total LTEN courses must be completed. At least 1 must be an upper division LTEN course, but up to 2 courses may be from the following lower division LTEN courses: LTEN 21, LTEN 22, LTEN 23, LTEN 25, LTEN 26, LTEN 27, LTEN 28, or LTEN 29

LTKO 1A \rightarrow LTKO 1B \rightarrow LTKO 1C \rightarrow LTKO 2A \rightarrow LTKO 2B \rightarrow LTKO 2C \rightarrow LTKO 3 \rightarrow LTKO 100 For the last 2 steps you may take LTKO 3 twice and LTKO 100 once <u>OR</u> take LTKO 3 once and LTKO 100 twice.

<u>Latin</u>

$\overline{\text{LTLA 1}} \rightarrow \text{LTLA 2} \rightarrow \text{LTLA 3} \rightarrow \text{UD LTLA}$

There is also a Summer Session option of LTLA 4, which counts as LTLA 1, LTLA 2, and LTLA 3 combined.

<u>Spanish</u>

LISP 1A/1AX \rightarrow LISP 1B/1BX \rightarrow LISP 1C/1CX \rightarrow LTSP 2A \rightarrow LTSP 2B \rightarrow LTSP 2C \rightarrow LTSP 50 A/B/C \rightarrow UD LTSP For the last 2 steps you may take 2 LTSP 50 courses (A, B, or C) and 1 UD LTSP course <u>OR</u> you may take 1 LTSP 50 course (A, B, or C) and 2 UD LTSP courses.

The courses that are **bold** are the ones that will directly apply to the Secondary Literature Requirement for your major, so they must be taken for a letter grade. All other courses leading up to those may be taken pass/no pass.
