 - c. Up to 1 additional instance of Thesis Writing (LTWR 295)
 - d. Up to 6 additional seminars in Comparative Literature (LTCO), Cultural Studies (LTCS), English Literature (LTEN), and/or Spanish Literature (LTSP)
 - e. Up to 6 additional seminars in Art Practice or Theory (COGR 237, VIS 211, VIS 212, VIS 213, VIS 215, and/or VIS 216)
 - f. With pre-approval only, up to 6 instances of independent study in a guided Writing Project (LTWR 298)

Please keep in mind that MFA students will take more than these 18 courses during a three-year program (as they must enroll in 12 units each quarter). The requirements above are the core courses you must complete to graduate, and they should be prioritized during the first two years.
